Purpose & Overview	 The Transport Manager position in Wales and West Utilities is a diverse and challenging role, principally managing a small Transport team and key strategic partners to deliver excellent service to the internal customer community of managers and engineers. To deliver a fit for purpose fleet (incl plant), prioritising safety & efficiency to ensure WWU can deliver on its strategic objectives. To contract manage various outsourced service providers acting as contract owner to ensure service delivery to support the wider business. Ensures the continuous & effective management of the fleet to meet compliance with Road Transport Law & Operator License requirements. Provides advice and support to manager community to ensure Operator License compliance Guides wider business towards net zero fleet.
Key Accountabilities	 Manage and enforce processes that ensure Operator License compliance. Ensure driver licensing & drivers' hours compliance. Inform amendments to Road Transport Law to relevant persons Advise and inform on all legislative updates to relevant operational personnel regarding Operator License compliance, record keeping requirements & vehicle maintenance and condition reporting. Maintain O Licence data to the satisfaction of the Office of the Traffic Commissioner and DVSA. Maintain accuracy of fleet and business data held on Gov.UK website. Manage and review scheduled depot audit programme covering all operational departments, to ensure continuous & effective compliance with Road Transport Law & the conditions of WWU Operator Licenses. Investigate and advise on opportunities to improve aspects of providing continuous and effective control. Ensure fleet processes comply with legislative requirements of continuous motor insurance. Support and advise driver community. Strategic Supplier Management:
	Manage third party suppliers within the main fleet management contract to ensure effective problem resolution and minimise delays, ensure effective vehicle downtime management.



- Manage the supply contracts for the purchase and conversion of vehicles & plant that support the fleet replacement programme. Liaising with suppliers on specification, cost and lead times
- Manage asset disposal provision to ensure processes minimises operational disruption ensure fleet assets realise maximum residual value.
- Other 3rd party management (Fleet Management, Fuel Cards, telemetry)
- Manage the provision of company cars, covering all aspects of operational management resolving queries from drivers and managers

- Manage fleet maintenance budget.
- Ensure fleet assets realise maximum residual value.
- Manages the provision of fuel card contract. Monitor & challenge data accuracy with fuel card suppliers

Commercial Management:

- Cultivate relationships with account management team in fleet management contract to ensure effective delivery of service.
- Ensure an effective management of accident reporting for company cars & commercial vehicles Identify & challenge avoidable cost & ensure effective recovery of uninsured losses.
- Provides monthly & adhoc reporting to Operations & Finance departments.
- Advise on any new technology/functionality in data capture that offers commercial advantage.
- Cultivate relationships with account management team in fleet telematics contract to ensure effective delivery of service.
